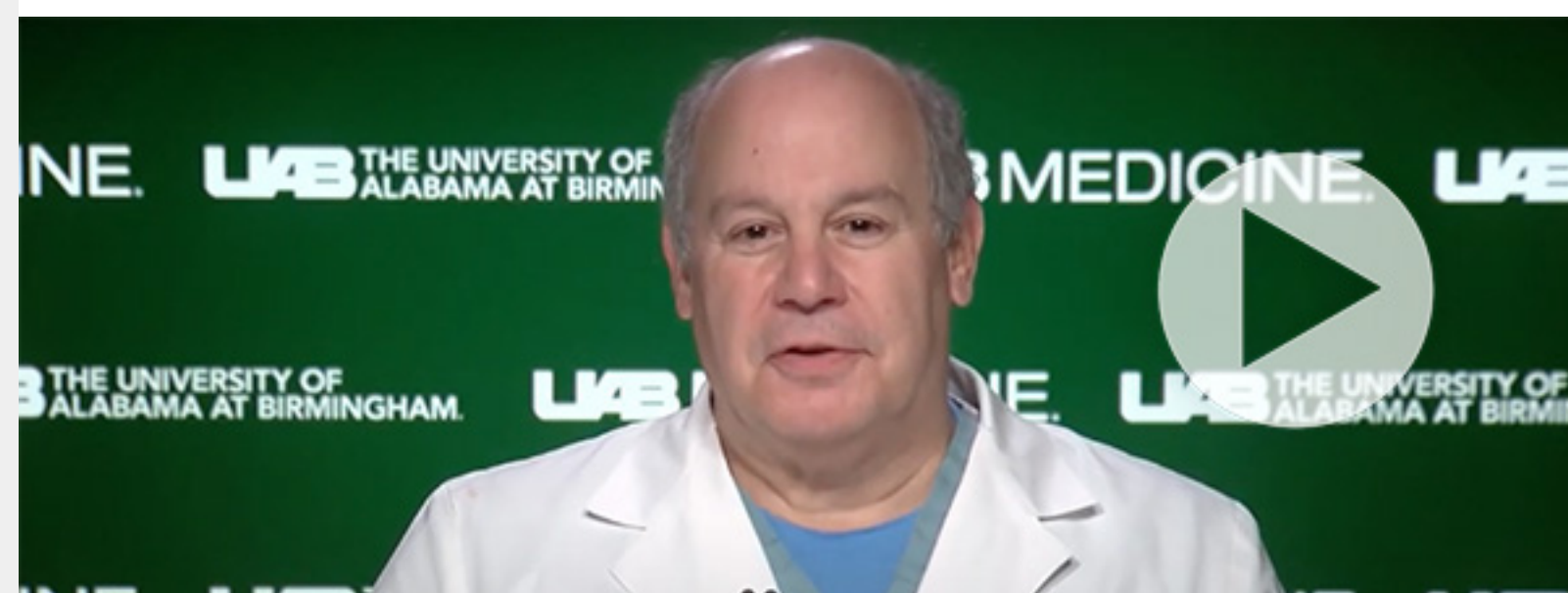

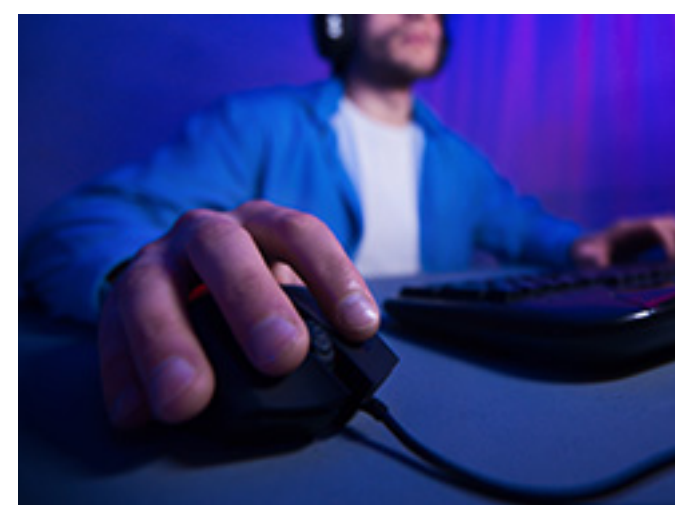
Limited loaner laptops are available

Checklist for COVID-19



Here's your checklist for return to classes

Training modules must be complete and your testing results cleared through Student Health. You need to register on Verily and download the GuideSafe app to get your daily passport. See the complete list and read more online.



Face masks are mandatory

Everyone is required to wear masks while on campus — indoors and outside — to protect themselves and others against novel coronavirus and is encouraged to wear them in the community. Follow these guidelines to ensure you are covering up correctly. You can report non-compliance with COVID-19 safety precautions.

Healthcheck is required daily for everyone

Students must complete the COVID-19 assessment tool seven days a week, and your assigned risk level will be communicated to the GuideSafe™ Event Passport system. Failure to accurately and honestly report symptoms and/or exposures or any attempt to falsify your Healthcheck will be referred for appropriate disciplinary action.
