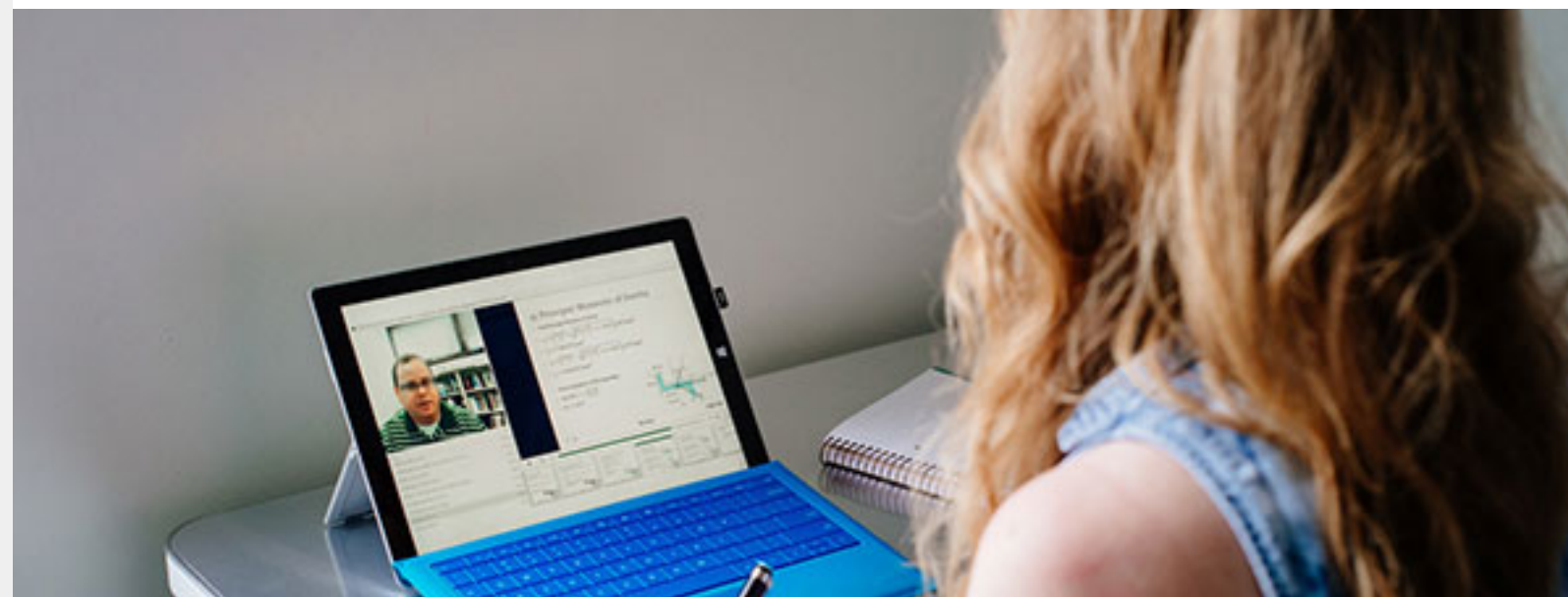
UA System board renames Wallace Building
