Help keep UAB safe: Report concerning behavior

UAB operates with an eye for safety — from 100-plus accredited police officers and a fleet of patrols to more than 6,400 security cameras throughout buildings, parking decks and outdoor areas. Yet, one of UAB's best defenses is the timely observation of a student or employee. Faculty, staff or students who perceive an imminent threat to safety should call 911 or the UAB Police Department at 205-934-3535. Situations and behaviors of concern that are clearly not emergencies can be reported to UAB's Behavioral Threat Assessment and Management team.

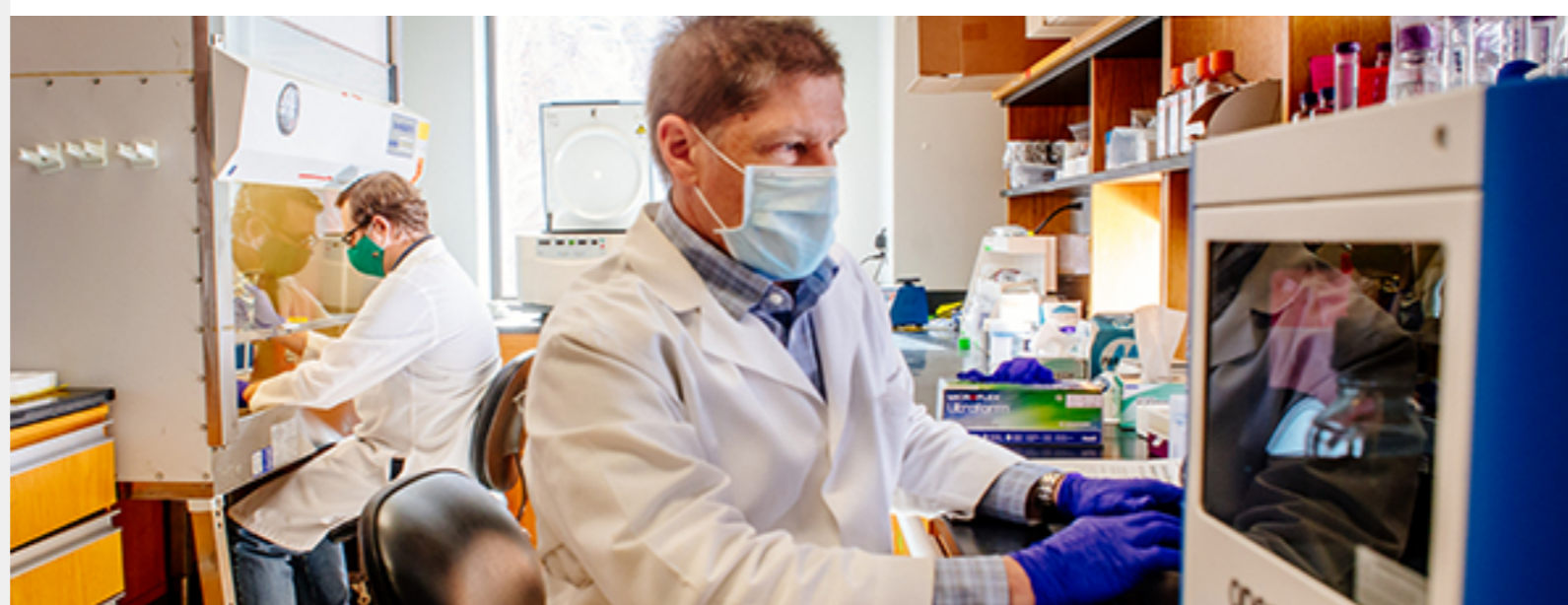
Performance review period open through Sept. 30

UAB researchers discover a potent, universal coronavirus monoclonal antibody therapy

Effective for all COVID-19 variants and developed by researchers at UAB, Texas Biomedical Research Institute and biopharmaceutical company Aridis, the antibody cocktail is delivered via a nasal dose and also is effective against SARS, MERS and several cold viruses. The antibodies are engineered potentially to last a year or more.
