


Juried student art exhibition to host reception tomorrow

U.S. could reach herd immunity by late spring

By adding the number of people who have tested positive to the number of people vaccinated and those with natural or acquired immunity, scientists estimate we will reach herd immunity in May, says UAB epidemiologist Suzanne Judd, Ph.D. There will be isolated outbreaks, and a strong vaccination campaign will need to continue.



These 6 things can keep you safe while you socialize with your pod

Socialize safely in your pod by masking in close quarters such as cars, not sharing drinks or food and avoiding enclosed spaces — and if a pod-member has close contact with someone who tests positive for COVID-19, follow this checklist.

Does the COVID-19 vaccine affect fertility or pregnancy?

Two UAB experts say the available data demonstrates the vaccine does not affect fertility, but it does significantly lower the risk of COVID-19 infection and severe complications that could be could be more detrimental to a pregnant woman's health plus pass on helpful antibodies to the baby.

Learn ways a budget, crafted for your individual lifestyle, can help you meet your goals 6 p.m. Feb. 25.


Tell your story in six words
