Green Labs finds cool way to reuse lab ice packs 😣


Thousands of ice packs are used in deliveries to UAB research labs each year — the same kinds used in meal-kit delivery services, which can stay cold for days, unlike regular ice. To divert them from the landfill, UAB's Green Labs program is donating 200 lbs. of ice packs per month to local organizations: Farmers selling their wares at the Market at Pepper Place use them to keep eggs and produce cool for customers, while Meals on Wheels depends on the packs to keep perishable items like milk cold during deliveries.
