Following more than 20 years at UAB and a decade of service as dean of the Collat School of Business, Eric Jack, Ph.D., will retire pending selection of his successor. While under Jack's leadership, the school saw student enrollment grow by 42%; he also facilitated the \$25 million gift from Charles and Patsy Collat to name the school and successfully raised the funds necessary to design and construct a new \$37.5 million state-of-the-art building.
