Researchers awarded \$11.2 million for heart attack recovery research

Jianyi "Jay" Zhang, M.D., Ph.D., chair of the Department of Biomedical Engineering, and colleagues were awarded a five-year NIH grant to study how the growth of new heart muscle cells may restore dead tissue left from a heart attack.

Results from this 2020 study led by Zhang reported that newborn pigs who underwent surgery to the heart's left ventricle could better regenerate heart muscle cells — and new results from the same model showing changes in gene expression could help researchers in their search for ways to repair human hearts



following a heart attack.

Parpura is a star — in the field of astrocytes

Vladimir Parpura, M.D., Ph.D., professor in the Department of Neurobiology, was listed as the second-highest cited expert in the world on astrocytes — the star-shaped cells crucial for nervous system health — based on his decade of research in the discipline and an analysis of PubMed.



Amsler named Sigma Xi Fellow


