UAB programs continue to rise in 2023 rankings

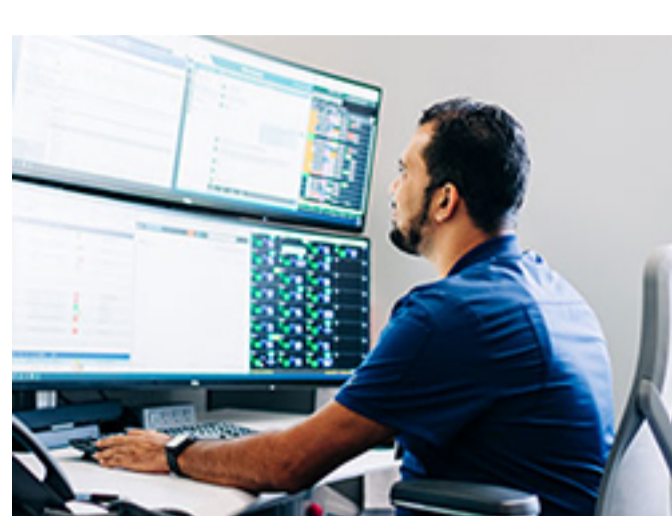

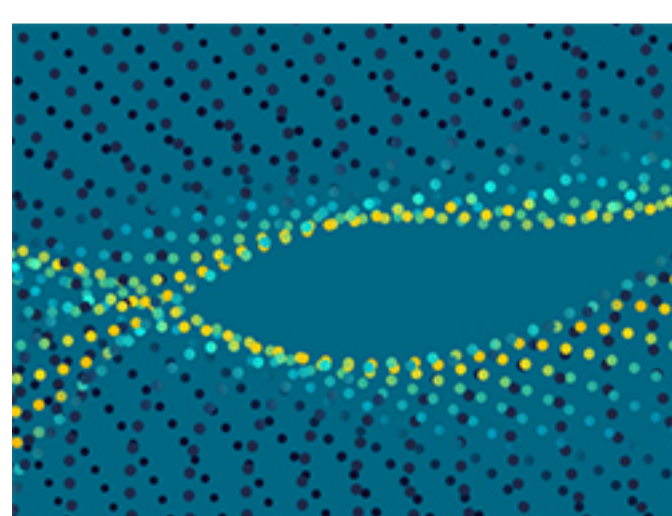

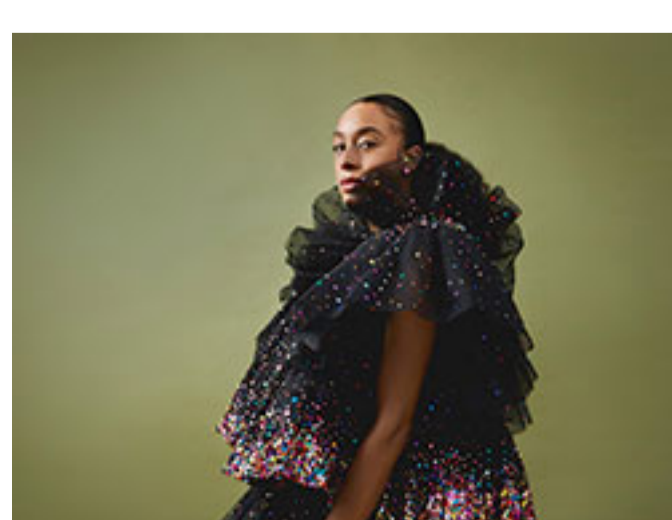
