Things to know

Share feedback about UAB Police and Public Safety

Employees and students can share comments, commendations and other information on UAB Police and Public Safety regarding the agency's quality of service with the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, with which UAB has been accredited since 1995. The annual on-site assessment verifies that UAB continues to meet specifically defined standards necessary to maintain accreditation. The submission portal will be available on uab.edu/police beginning March 31 for 60 days.

Introducing the new cellular device and wireless service request form

A new cellular device and wireless service request form will debut April 3 in the IT Service Portal, removing the need for a PDF request. The purchase of cellular service and devices still must be approved by an employee's department, but the new online form automates the approval process.

Get a discounted rate on personal training certification

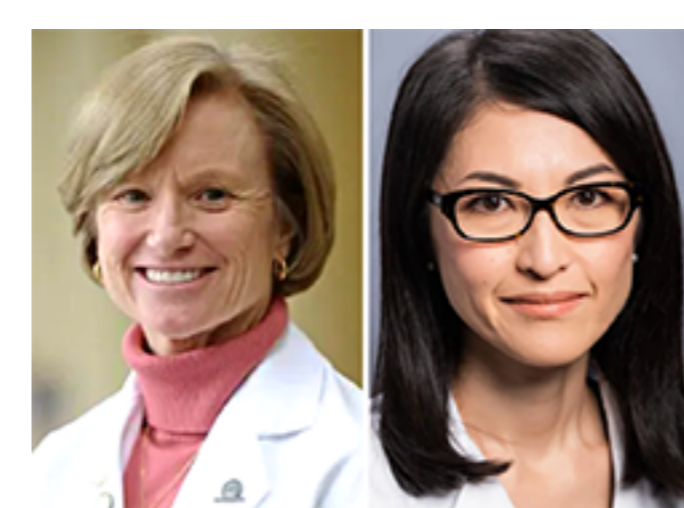
The certification, normally \$1,500, is \$799 for University Recreation members through a partnership with URec and NASM.
