

Virtually all Alabamians could benefit from gene-based drug prescribing, statewide study finds

Analyzing gene sequences and prescriptions for 3,300-plus participants in the Alabama Genomic Health Initiative, UAB scientists estimate 98.6% of Alabamians have actionable genotypes and a significant number are prescribed affected medications.



Answers to questions about alternative work pilot program

Amm awarded R21 grant to further genetic research

Hope Amm, Ph.D., will use the NIH grant to develop a new model for ameloblastomas - rare oral tumors that occur within the bones of the jaw — to determine best methods for imaging the tumors before or


