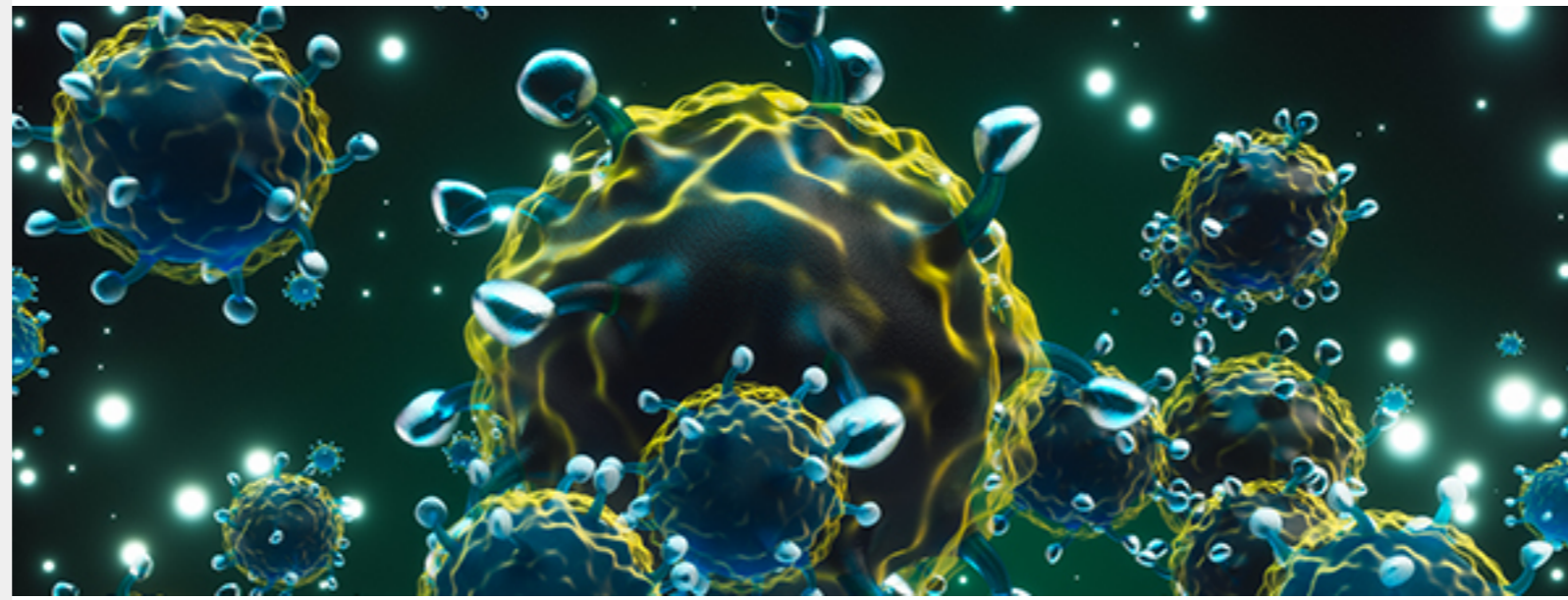

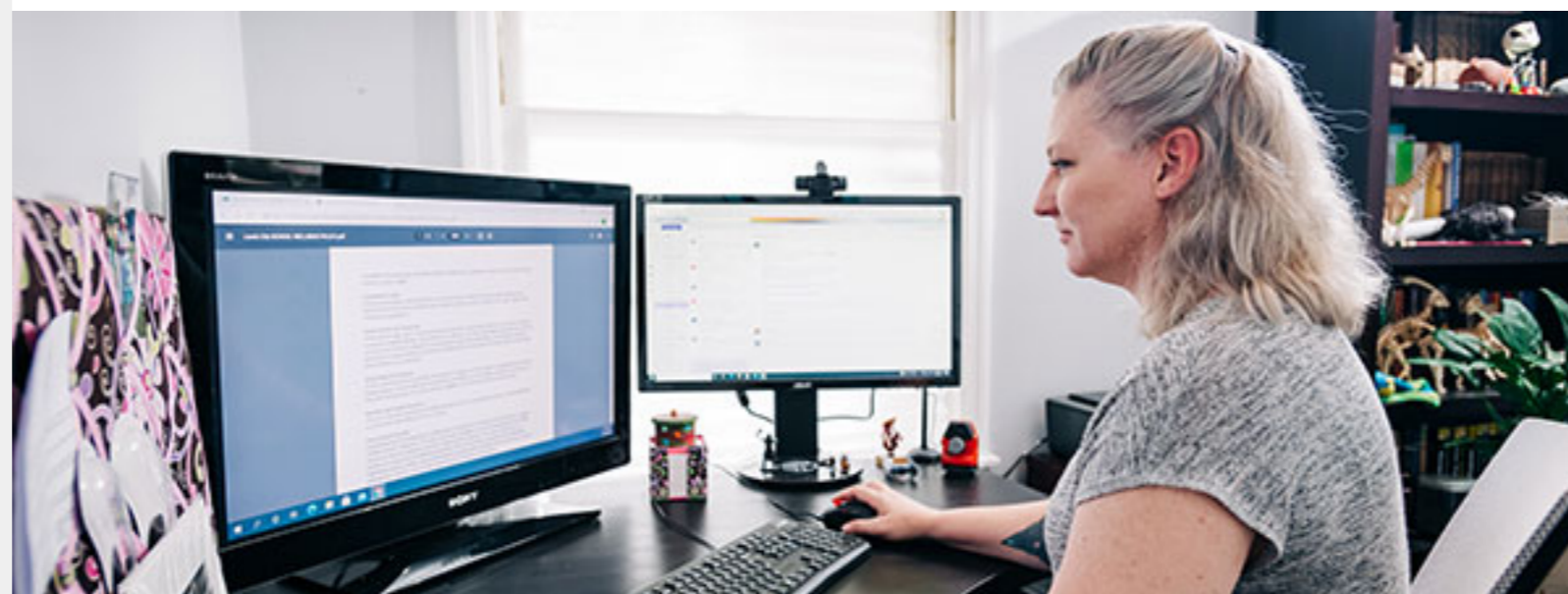
July 5 is observed holiday for Independence Day
