Drive to campus? Update your account and avoid a ticket

All UAB parking permit-holders should update their vehicle registration information or get a free replacement permit in April to ensure they are complying with parking policy.

Vote in faculty senate election through April 26

All faculty may vote for senators to represent their academic unit, plus the chair-elect and associate chair of the UAB Faculty Senate online.

File annual ethics report by April 30

UAB supervisors whose job includes management of state funds in certain capacities or who meet a salary threshold of \$81,000 are required to complete an annual Statement of Economic Interests form. Employees whose primary assignments are in the UAB Hospital are exempt.
