




Staff Council to meet Aug. 28

Inhaling live bacteria improves lung function


UAB researchers used a powder mixture of Lactobacilli to reduce neutrophilic inflammation and reduce a broad swath of inflammatory markers in preclinical models of the lung diseases COPD and bronchopulmonary dysplasia, which affect millions of older adults and premature infants, respectively.


